There are over 70 passages that mention fish, fishing or fishermen in the Bible. There are several lists of Jesus' apostles but Peter and Andrew, James and John are always mentioned first. Of course, they were fishermen. Why? Because fishermen are ideally suited to be apostles.

They have the right attitude and handle adversity well. They take what life deals them. If they're not biting today, they are certain they'll be biting tomorrow. And adversity comes to us all, but it seems to be attracted to fishermen. Sudden storms; the motor quits; if they run out of gas its always on the other side of the lake; mosquitoes, gnats and flies feast on them; then someone falls in from too much imbibing, yet they just keep coming back for more.

They have **purpose** and **persistence**. Nothing can stop a fisherman when he's heard they're biting. He would fish with purpose everyday of the week, if his wife would let him, because he knows he was born to fish. And if you see one guy on a lake with 300 holes drilled in the ice, you know you're dealing with persistence. Either that or he got a new gas ice auger for Christmas and he can't stop trying it out.

They go through life with **hope** and **happiness**. They live in hope that the big one's going to take their line and run and fight, and run and fight, and run some more until they've got the makings of a great fish tale, and a picture to prove that the fish was the whopper, and not their story about catching it. If happiness isn't coming their way, they create their own. Even if they aren't biting, at least they're out fishing and that beats working any day of the week.

And finally they have a deep **spirituality**. What could be more spiritual than sitting in a boat on a lake that looks like a sheet of glass, and for some reason the mosquitoes aren't biting that day, but the sunnies are. And you're sharing it with someone you love. And you KNOW there is a GOD and you come off the lake ready to tackle the world. Those are the kind of people our Lord is looking for.

Now we just need to get them into church, so we can send them out into the world to use their gifts, fishing for people like them, who God has prepared to follow his path.


I'll close with some final thoughts:





Faye called the meeting to order at 11:27 am on July 13, 2025

Report Highlights:

- Pastor: July 27 will be a joint UVP service, 10:30 am, Halstad Lutheran Church east lawn with potluck to follow. The service is in conjunction with the Pirate-Panther All-School Reunion.
- Secretary: Minutes from May 18, 2025 meeting. There was no June council meeting.
- Treasurer: May income for ministry:
 \$3,315, expenses for ministry:
 \$7,915.27, net -\$4,600.27, general fund -\$76.13; parsonage taxes was a large
 May expense. June income for ministry:
 \$10,496.68, expenses for ministry:
 \$4,699.33, net \$5,797.35, general fund
 \$6,064.15; parsonage rent is up-to-date.
- Deacon: Signs talking about the Mission of the Year, National Child Safety Council/Norman County, are in the entry way.
- Trustee: No damage to the building from the June 20/21 storms. Mike will spray weeds around the foundation and sidewalk, and pressure wash the lower exterior brick. Faye reached out to Laughing Earth in Ada for landscape ideas and will follow up on the church bell. Del is contacting a welder about new front railings. All projects are scheduled for completion by the 150th anniversary celebration.
- Board of Education: VBS is planned for August 11-14, 5-7:30 pm, for K-5th grade at Immanuel.

Motion by Tod, seconded by Mike, to approve the reports. Motion carried.

Unfinished Business:

 Immanuel's 150th Anniversary will be September 14, 2025; committee is planning on worship, catered meal, afternoon program.

New Business:

- The Community Needs Fund exists to provide limited financial assistance to people in need. Previously, undesignated coffee donations were allocated to this fund. The current balance is \$1,308.72. Consensus to redirect future undesignated coffee donations in the general fund. Motion by Amy, seconded by Bonnie to authorize up to \$20 per request for gas from the Community Needs fund. Payment will be made directly to the business. Requests for assistance beyond gas will be considered individually by the council. Motion carried.
- Immanuel will host the corn feed in conjunction with Hendrum Family Fun Night, August 27. WELCA serving committee will organize. Proceeds will be divided ½ to our Mission of the Year and ½ to the general fund.

Next council meeting is August 10 following worship. With no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:01 p.m., and we closed with the Lord's Prayer.
